Rationale:

That all children wear school uniform when attending school, representing the school or when participating in a school organised event outside normal school hours. The uniform is to be worn with pride and should be well looked after.

Purposes of a school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride within Highfields.
- Brings about a sense of community
- Is practical and smart
- Identifies the children within the school
- Prevents children from coming to school in fashion clothes that could be distracting in class
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Is regarded as suitable wear for school and good value for money by most parents
- Is designed with health and safety in mind

Guidelines

The following items make up our uniform:

**PLEASE PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON EVERY ITEM OF ACADEMY CLOTHING.
CHECK YOUR CHILD'S SHOES REGULARLY TO ENSURE THEY ARE WELL FITTING.**

Hair should be neat and hair should be the child's natural colour. **Extreme hairstyles and shaved patterns are not permitted.**

P.E. KIT

Navy blue shorts and white T-shirt - Indoor P.E

Navy blue or black tracksuit bottoms/joggers- plain-Outdoor P.E.

Children will not be allowed to wear football shirts/strips or T-shirts with logos.

The children should have trainers / pumps for outdoor PE.

Jewellery

The wearing of earrings or any jewellery other than watches **is not permitted** in the Academy. There is a risk of serious injury in activities such as PE as well as at play and dinner times. Also these items can get easily lost causing upset. Finally, valuable teaching

time is taken up helping children to remove and put jewellery back on after various lessons. Any children coming to the Academy with jewellery will be asked to remove the items. They will be returned into your keeping at the end of the Academy day.

The role of parents

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy. We believe that parents have a duty to send their children to school correctly dressed and ready for their daily school work. One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child had the correct uniform and that it is clean and in good repair.
