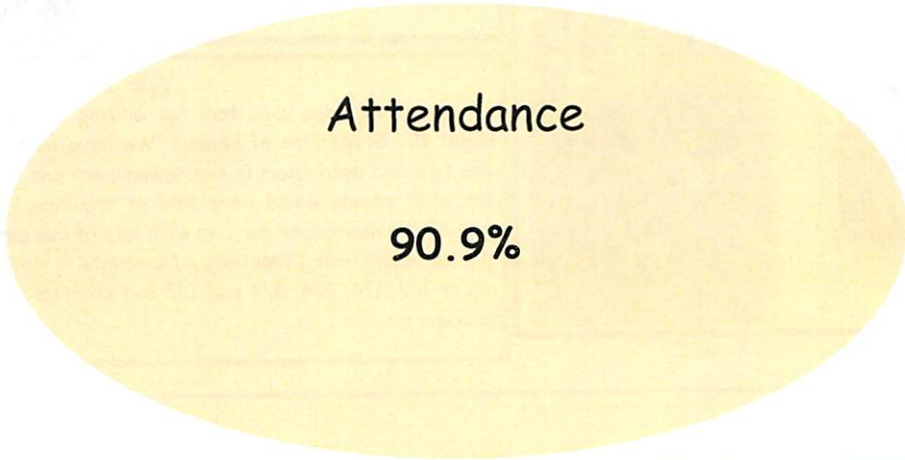

Foundation Stage

This week we have been looking at shapes again and playing games to identify, match and take turns in small groups. The children have been practising Learn Its in Maths. This week in year 1 we have started our new topic 'Moon zoom' and the children are completely absorbed in to this learning. We have also started a new story in literacy called 'way back home' which is about a journey to the moon. The children have been mapping out the story.
