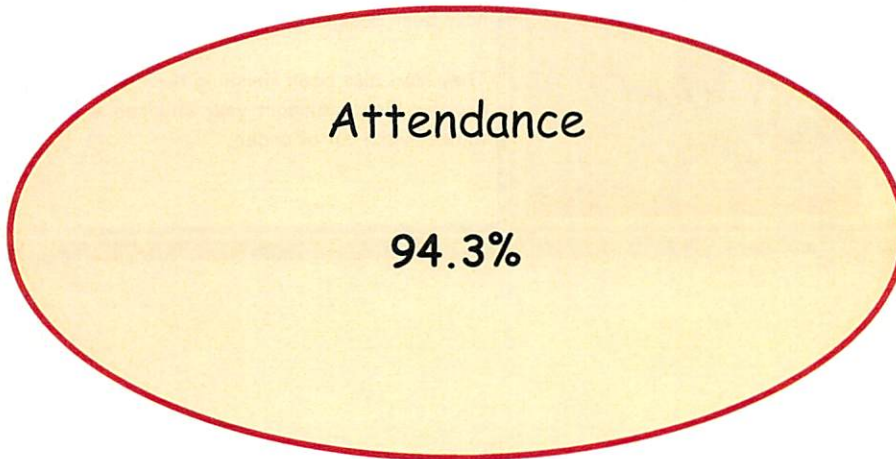

Foundation Stage
